ABOUT NAPERVILLE CHORUS: Founded in 1976; is a non-auditioned SATB chorus, composed of 100+ singers. We are an organization dedicated to the advancement of choral music, the encouragement of participation in group singing, the presentation of choral programs, and the encouragement of cultural music in the community. We typically perform traditional choral music repertoire, but have explored various genres, including jazz, contemporary and folk. The Chorus generally performs twice yearly at Wentz Concert Hall and Fine Arts Center in Naperville. The chorus operates as a 501(C)(3) non-profit organization.

- Project management skills to plan, prepare, and direct performances. Production and execution of the program will be facilitated by the Board of Directors and members

- Effective conducting skills for a variety of ensemble types

- Competent piano skills

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Plan and conduct weekly rehearsals on Monday evenings from 7:30pm 9:30pm in Naperville, plus any additional stage rehearsals as needed for final concert preparations.
- Lead the Chorus through a rehearsal season stretching from September to May; may also include a July 4th collaboration with the Naperville Municipal Band
- Conduct a minimum of two major concerts per year (Fall, Spring)
- Work with Assistant Director and Board to retain an orchestra and soloists
- Collaborate with the established Assistant Director/Accompanist
- Identify opportunities for the Chorus to collaborate with other musicians, groups, and at different venues.
- Work with the Board to select repertoire, and to ensure that current season's music is selected and purchased in a timely fashion
- Attend Board meetings, when invited
- Assist Board in planning annual budget
- Attend Chorus Annual meeting
